# NOTIFICATION OF ESSENTIAL MAINTENANCE WORKS M69 Northbound junction 1 to junction 2

I'm writing to let you know that we'll be carrying out essential maintenance works on the M69 Northbound junction 1 to junction 2

These works will take place between **8pm** and **6am**, **Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> September** to **Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> September**, with the road being open from 6am on Saturday 28th September.

We will be continuing our work on the M69 Southbound - M1 Junction 21 to M69 Junction 1 from week commencing **30**<sup>th</sup> **September**. These works will take place between **8pm** and **6am**, **Monday** to **Thursday**.

Please note that all planned works may be subject to change due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

## How will the work affect traffic?

To keep our programme for these works as short as possible and to minimise disruption to the local community, residents, businesses and road users, we'll be working under a full southbound carriageway closure including slip roads.

During these closures fully signed diversion routes will be in place, which have been agreed with the local authority.

## How will the work affect businesses and residents?

We'll make sure that access to businesses and residences is maintained wherever possible.

We apologise for any inconvenience caused and will do our very best to complete the work as quickly as possible, keeping disturbances and noise to a minimum.



# **Diversion Route**


## **M69 Southbound Diversion Route**

Traffic wishing to travel southbound on the M69 will be diverted south on the M1 J21 until M1 J20. At the roundabout take the 3<sup>rd</sup> exit into the A4303 and travel west until the roundabout with the A5, at the roundabout take the 4<sup>th</sup> exit onto the A5 North towards Hinckley, continue along the A5 until the roundabout with the M69. End of diversion.




#### M69 NB Diversion Route Junction 1

Traffic wishing to travel northbound on the M69 will be diverted south onto the A5 and will continue along the A5 south until the roundabout with the A4303. At the roundabout take the 1st exit and continue west until the roundabout with the M1 J20, at the roundabout take the 1st exit onto the M1 northbound. End of diversion.



## M69 NB Diversion Route Junction 2

Traffic wishing to travel north at junction 2 will be diverted onto the B4669 Hinckley Road, until its junction with Sharnford Road where it will turn right, at the junction with Sharnford Road and B4114 Coventry Road traffic will turn right, traffic will continue along B4114 Coventry Road until its junction with the A5 south, Turn left onto A5 south and follow diversion for M69 NB Junction 1. End of diversion.
