NOTIFICATION OF ESSENTIAL SAFETY DRAINAGE MAINTENANCE WORKS A5 Soar Brook Culvert

I am writing to let you know that we will be carrying out essential drainage maintenance works to the A5 at Soar Brook Culvert.

During our scheme of work, we will:

- clear all vegetation
- repair drainage system, installation of a new headwall and safety barrier
- reinstate verge

When will the work take place?

This work has now been re-scheduled with revised dates now due to start on **8th March 2023** and is scheduled for completion by **end of April 2023**.

Please note that all our planned roadworks may be subject to change due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

How will the work affect traffic?

To keep our programme for these works as short as possible and to minimise disruption to the local community, residents, businesses, and road users we will work under full carriageway overnight closures between **8pm** and **6am**, **Monday to Friday**.

Some elements of the work will require **full weekend** closures from **8pm Friday to 6am Monday** and these have been programmed as follows;

- **Friday 17 March to Monday 20 March 2023**
- **Friday 24 March to Monday 27 March 2023**
- **Friday 31 March to Monday 3 April 2023**

We will also have in place a contingency midweek closure planned for **Tuesday 2 May to Thursday 4 May 2023** to cover any unforeseen circumstances due to weather or clashes on the network.

There will be a temporary speed limit for the duration of the whole scheme from 50mph to 40mph. Also all Lay by's within the work extents will be closed 24/7.

During these closures fully signed diversion routes will be in place, which have been agreed with the Local Authority.

How will the work affect traffic?

During these closures, fully signed diversion routes (please see below) will be in place, which have been agreed with the local authority. All carriageways and slip roads will be open as usual outside of our working hours.

We apologise for any inconvenience caused and will do our very best to complete the work as quickly as possible, keeping disturbances and noise to a minimum.
