## What matters to you

- **Anti Social Behaviour** —You have told us that Anti-Social behaviour causes you concern. This can be things like excessive noise, parties, smoking drugs and more. We will be working with partners to ensure we can tackle these issues and prevent them occurring again.
- **Motor vehicle crime**—You told us that you were concerned about vehicle crime. This can be theft of motor vehicles or theft from motor vehicles, this also includes theft of tools from vans and theft of catalytic convertors.
- **Road Safety**—You have told us that Road Safety is a priority, this includes things like Speeding, Insurance, MOT and driving offences.

## What have we done #yousaidwedid

- **Anti Social Behaviour**—The local neighbourhood team conduct regular patrols in highlighted problem areas. Officers will advertise on our social media channels when they are out and about patrolling. We record all ASB on our shared system with Harborough District Council and together we will do what we can to reduce problems and provide you with the satisfaction. We continue to encourage you to report concerns and locations to us, we need this information to conduct more targeted patrols.
- **Road Safety**—the local beat team regularly conduct speed checks and deal with any traffic issues that are reported on the beat. We endeavour to update via social media or Neighbourhood Link when we complete these duties.

## What have we done #yousaidwedid

### ASB Patrols:

The beat team regularly patrol ASB hotspot areas. We have completed checks at local parks to ensure a safe environment for everyone to enjoy.

We have also completed regular patrols at the Leire Lane Fishing Pond. This is still an issue being raised regarding young people trespassing onto the land and swimming in the water. Please do not trespass onto this area or drop people off to go there. The water is deep and there is a safety risk with any open water area.



### Broughton Astley Parish Council:

PC Tom Glover and PS Charlie Davies attended the parish council meeting on the 18th of July. It was great to hear from the councillors and discuss any issues or points they wished to raise.

### Visit to Teapots Nursery in Broughton Astley:
