What matters to you

- Anti Social Behaviour You have told us that Anti-Social behaviour causes you concern. This can be things like excessive noise, parties, smoking drugs and more. We will be working with partners to ensure we can tackle these issues and prevent them occurring again.
- Motor vehicle crime—You told us that you were concerned about vehicle crime. This can be theft of motor vehicles or theft from motor vehicles, this also includes theft of tools from vans and theft of catalytic convertors.
- Road Safety—You have told us that Road Safety is a priority, this includes things like Speeding, Insurance,
 MOT and driving offences.

What have we done #yousaidwedid

- Anti Social Behaviour—The local neighbourhood team conduct regular patrols in highlighted problem areas.
 - Officers will advertise on our social media channels when they are out and about patrolling We record all ASB on our shared system with Harborough District Council and together we will do what we can to reduce problems and provide you with the satisfaction.
 - We continue to encourage you to report concerns and locations to us, we need this information to conduct more targeted patrols.
- Road Safety—the local beat team regularly conduct speed checks and deal with any traffic issues that are
 reported on the beat. We endeavour to update via social media or Neighbourhood Link when we complete
 these duties.

What have we done #yousaidwedid

- Due to reports of eggs being thrown at addresses in Broughton Astley your local beat team have completed patrols in the local area and have spoken to a number of people in relation to these issues
- Your local beat team have also completed patrols in relation to anti-social driving—officers located
 a vehicle on Swannington Road in Broughton Astley where the vehicle was shown to be on false
 registration plates. It was subsequently recovered.
- From concerns raised around issues in parks, the beat team have patrolled and regularly check the local parks. Windsor Way park was one noted to be having issues with ASB in the evening and following these complaints we regularly patrol this area.
- The beat team have also completed a visit to Woodfield School in Frolesworth to speak with the students and so they can asked questions about the police. It was great to see so many wanting to know more about our role and loads of questions asked.
- From reports of ASB down the end of Sutton on the Elms regarding vehicles, checks have been completed in the area and occupants of vehicles seen down there have been spoken to and advised for any ASB driving
